Reflections On Riverside

2013 Imagery Contest

The Frederick Law Olmsted Society invites Riverside-area High School students to submit their "Reflections on Riverside" to our 2013 Imagery Contest.

DEADLINE

Entries must be post-marked or e-mailed to imagerycontest@olmstedsociety.org by **April 30, 2013**.

THEME

To reflect or encourage reflection upon any of Riverside's natural spaces. Time should be spent outside in Riverside's landscape for inspiration.

CATEGORIES

POETRY. Any form or style.

VISUAL ARTS. All two-dimensional media (painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, digital art, etc.) are eligible.

RULES

1. Students in grades 9-12 residing in District 208 may enter. Only one entry per student will be accepted per category.
2. Entries must be the student's original work, created for this contest. Works previously published are ineligible.
3. The face of all entries, including Visual Art, must be free of names and other information which could identify the student.
4. **Poems.** a. If mailed, poems must be typed on 8.5" x 11" paper and paper clipped to a completed Imagery Contest Entry Form.
b. If e-mailed, poems must be attached in MS Word. The body of the e-mail must contain the poem title, student's name, school, grade, home address, phone and e-mail.
5. **Visual Art** must be digitally photographed or scanned and saved in RGB color mode 5"x7" or larger as a 300 dpi JPG file no larger than 10 megabytes.

a. If mailed, Visual Art must be saved on CD and accompanied by a completed Entry Form, with the title matching the file name of the image on the CD.

b. If e-mailed, Visual Art must be attached to an e-mail that contains the title of the piece, the media, its size, the student's name, school, grade, home address, phone and e-mail.

6. Entering by e-mail constitutes both student and parental agreement to the Certification set forth on the 2013 Imagery Contest Entry Form.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Poetry: Strength of Theme (10), Appropriateness of Title (5), Imagery (20), Originality (25), Clarity and Tone (20), Suitability of Verse Style, Meter and Rhythm (15) and Appropriate Spelling and Grammar (5).

Visual Arts: Strength of Theme (20), Appropriateness of Title (5), Creativity/Originality (25), Composition, including elements of art and principles of design (25) and Craftsmanship and Technique, including quality of digital image submitted (25).

PRIZES

\$100 to the winner of the Poetry Division.

\$100 to the winner of the Visual Arts Division.

Entries may be featured in the Frederick Law Olmsted Society Newsletter and on its Website: www.olmstedsociety.org
All appropriate entries shall be published in professionally-bound volumes to be maintained in the Olmsted Collection and in the Local Authors Section of the Riverside Public Library.

Please Note: Family members of Reflections on Riverside Imagery Contest judges are not eligible to receive cash awards.
