



Three shingle oak trees were planted:



Possibility Place Nursery is partnering with the Village of Riverside and the Frederick Law Olmsted Society to raise awareness about oak trees in our community.

Possibility Place has donated 3 fifteen gallon shingle oak trees to the Village of Riverside for an OAKtober planting event to raise awareness of the diminishing oak populations in the Chicagoland area. It is our hope that these plantings will provide a greater understanding of the importance of oak trees and their role in our urban and natural landscapes. After all, oak trees provide a longer living tree cover, significant food web contributions, and enhance our landscapes. 
